3.2 Calculation of Rates

321 To the extent that mileage is a rate element associated with a particular

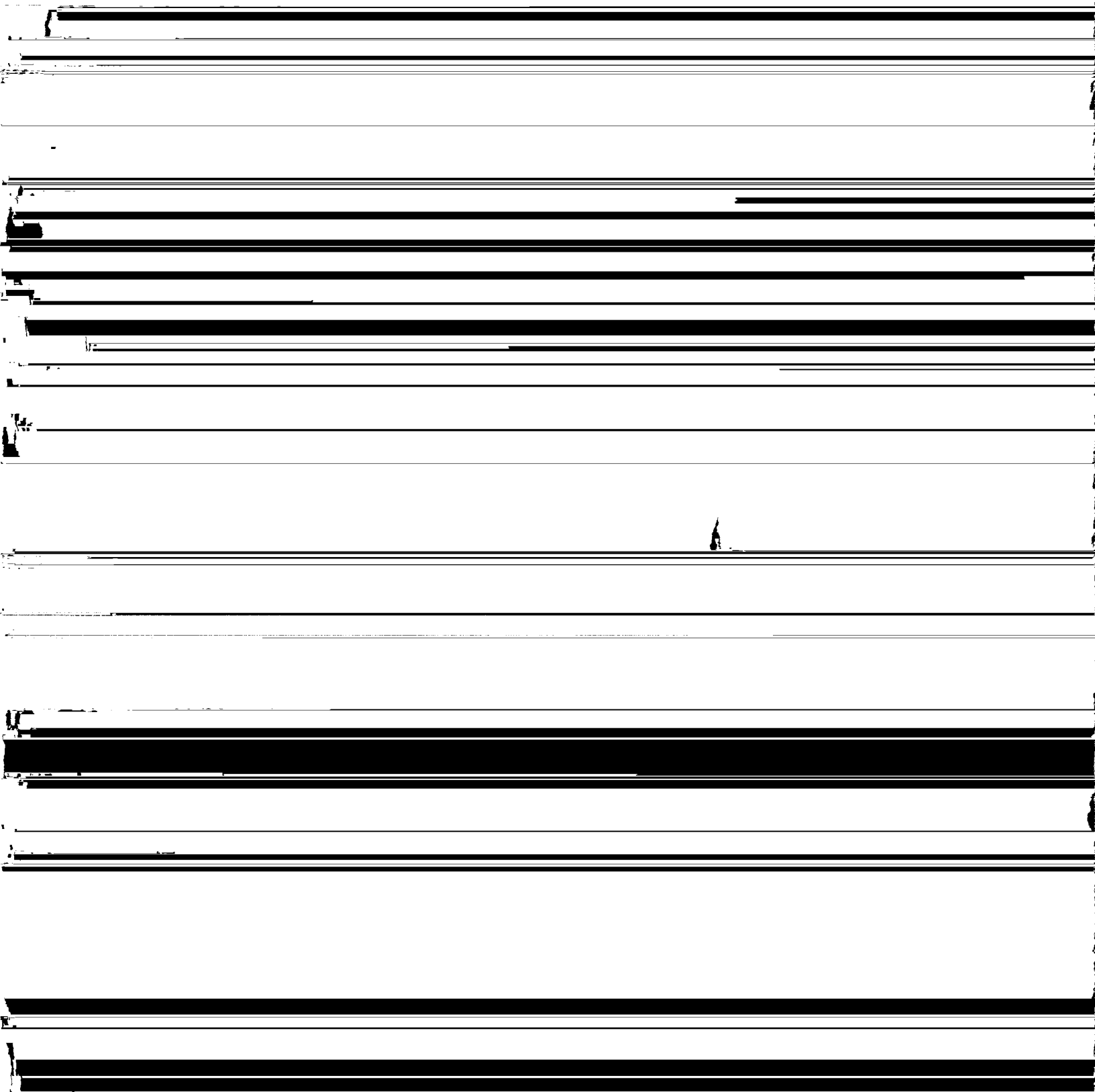
